Ideally...

-DC101 and DC401 start on the Monday after Labor Day—enough time to finish (ideally with celebration) before Thanksgiving weekend.

-DC201 and DC402 start on the week of the first Monday of the New Year (unless New Years Day is a Monday).

-Spiritual Disciplines Retreats are on the weekend between the 5th & 6th—and the 6th & 7th—weeks of DC101. (We've lightened the prep for DC in weeks 6 and 7. Second-best: the weekend after DC101 ends.)
