Week 2—bearing

The NIV translates “anechomai” in Ephesians 4:2 as “bearing with”. In what other ways does the NIV translate this Greek word? (*Optional*: List the verses and comment if you see anything interesting.)

Week 3—unwholesome

In Ephesians 4:29, the NIV translates “sapos” as “unwholesome”. How do they translate it elsewhere? List the verses and comment on its use.

Week 4—gift/grace

In I Peter 4:10, the NIV translates “charis” as “gift”. How does the NIV usually translate it and why is that interesting? What other Greek word (#5922) is closely related to “charis” (#5921)?

Week 5—tolerate

List the verses when the NIV translates words into the English word “tolerate”. Comment if you see anything interesting about how those Hebrew and Greek words are translated.

Week 6—(selfish) ambition

List the verses when the NIV translates Greek words into “(selfish) ambition”. Comment on the radically different implications of “ambition” in godly and ungodly contexts.

Week 7—flesh/body/sinful nature (sarx)

The Greek word “sarx” is one of the most important and versatile words in the New Testament. In what three ways is it most often translated? What is the difference between those three English terms? You can spend a little or a lot of time on this, but comment on anything you find interesting.

Week 8—“the world”

This is already included as question #4 in the DC course book.

Week 9—flee

The Greek term “pheugo” is usually translated flee or fled by the NIV. Look at the other verses which use this term and comment on anything you find interesting.
