

Week 2—training

The NIV translates five different Greek words as the English word “training” (or related words). At least three of the five are interesting. At the least, identify the Greek words and the English words that are directly related to them.

Week 3—daily life/walk (a la Eph 4:1; vs. zoe)

In I Thessalonians 4:12, the term “daily life” is translated from the Greek term “peripateo” How else is the Greek word translated? In particular, it is the opening word (and otherwise the key word) within Ephesians 4:1-6:9 What is the other common Greek word for “life” and what English words are related to it? Comment on anything else of interest

Week 4—work(s)

In Colossians 3:23-24, the term “work” is translated by the NIV from the Greek term “ergazomai” (#2237). A more common Greek word is similar (#2240). How else is this word often translated? You can spend a little or a lot of time on this, but comment on anything you find interesting.

Week 5—visits

Find the Greek word from which “visits” is translated by the NIV in I Peter 2:12 What English word is directly related to this Greek word? In what other three ways does the NIV translate this word?

Week 6—conversation

Find the Greek word from which “conversation” is translated by the NIV in Colossians 4:6. How is the word usually translated by the NIV? Comment on the significance of this word in general—and then with application to Paul’s use of the term in Colossians.

Week 7—root &/or eager

Look up the other times when the NIV uses the term “root” and comment on anything you find interesting.

Week 8—“wealth” in Proverbs (in NIV)

Look up the other times when the NIV uses the term “wealth” in Proverbs and comment on anything you find interesting.

Week 9—endurance, endure, endured, endures

Look up the other times when the NIV uses the term “endure” (or related terms) and comment on anything you find interesting.
